Burglary	76	57	-25
Disorderly	42	40	-4.76
Robbery	27	18	-33.33
Shoplifting	70	44	-37.14
Vandalism	170	117	-31.17
Total	555	447	-19.46

In 2019, the number of aggravated assaults, burglaries, disorderly incidents, robberies, shoplifting, and vandalisms decreased by the specified amounts compared to the same time frame in 2018.

 - Lowell will be using this system to provide text and email notifications for Lowell-specific alerts.
- LPD launched their Safe Watch Program on 4/2/19.
 - This program is designed to proactively gather pertinent information on individuals who have a disability or condition which could cause them to wander from their safe environment. This enables the LPD to begin a search as quickly as possible if that individual goes missing.
